State Street Crossing Traffic Impact Study

RC05-253 Rutledge moved, Eder seconded that upon the recommendation of the County Highway Engineer and the concurrence of the Managing Director, the Board accepts the final report of the independent study conducted by Parsons Brinckerhoff Michigan, Inc., for the State Street Crossing Development Traffic Impact Study, and authorizes the County Highway Engineer to use the findings of this study as the basis for developing a Road Improvement Agreement with the applicant(s) of the proposed commercial developments at the northeast corner of US-12 (Michigan Avenue) and State Road/Moon Road in Pittsfield Township. It is understood that the Board directs staff to work with the Michigan Department of Transportation to determine improvements that will be required for US-12 (Michigan Avenue) in the vicinity of the project, along with the timing of those improvements, so that traffic and roadway modifications required for the project can be considered as a whole. It is further understood that the Board directs staff to continue to consider additional information from the township, the Michigan Department of Transportation, citizens and others as additional mitigation measures are being evaluated. The Board further directs the Transportation Planner to incorporate the stated findings into a final report of the State Road Corridor Study, the status of which is pending the completion of the State Street Crossing Traffic Impact Study.
